





Ibrahim Hassan, 33 years old, from Tununu, a village in North Darfur, Sudan. He is taking online English courses and working sporadically as a house cleaner since he arrived in Cairo two years ago. He doesn't want to go back home due to the ongoing conflict in Darfur.
