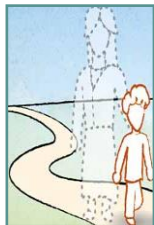

Unaccompanied Migrant Children (UMCs): Trends

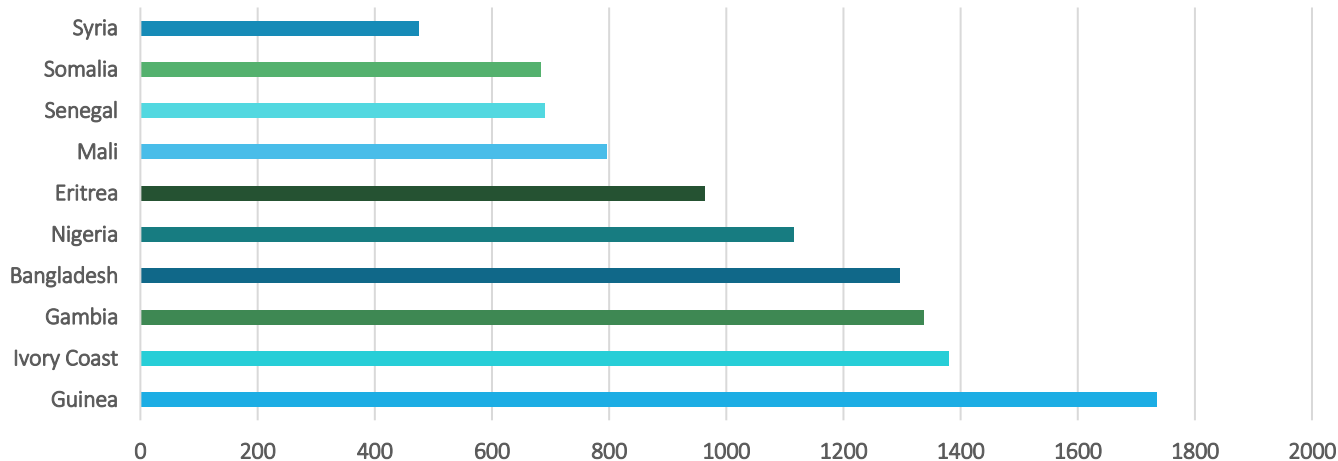


Unaccompanied children have been **separated from both parents and other relatives** and are not being cared for by an adult who, by law or custom, is responsible for doing so. [Read more.](#)

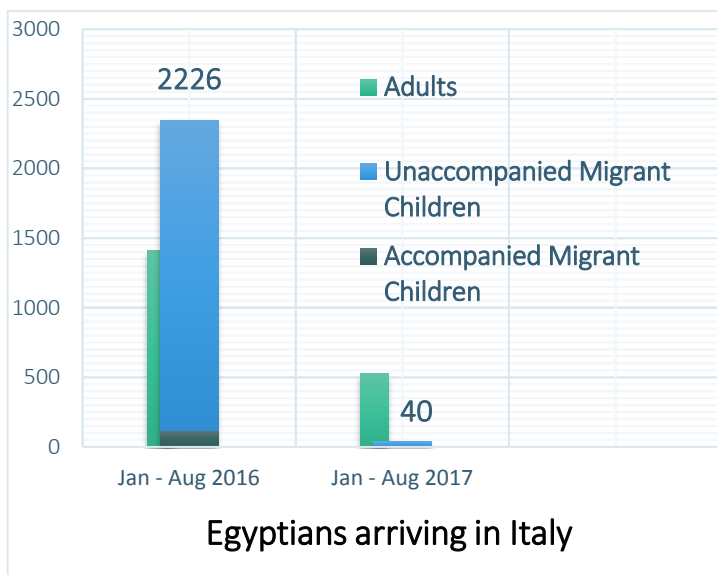


Separated children have been separated from both parents, or from their previous legal or customary primary caregiver, **but not necessarily from other relatives.** [Read more.](#)

UMCs & Egypt



In 2016, Egypt was the only case where the number of unaccompanied migrant children (UMC) – arriving in Italy – was higher than the total number of adult migrants. In August 2016, Egypt further ranked as the top sending country of UMCs.

98% decrease in the number of Egyptian UMCs arriving in Italy in Jan-Aug 2017, as compared to the same period in 2016

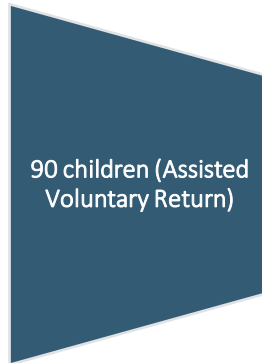
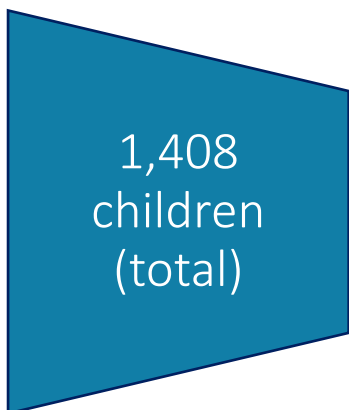
