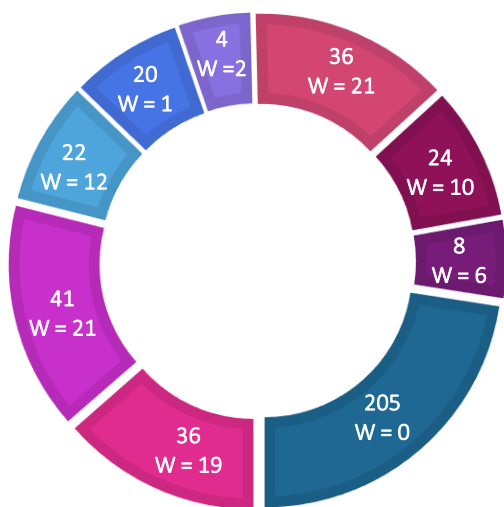

IN NUMBERS: TRAINED IN EGYPT BY IOM SINCE THE BEGINNING OF 2017

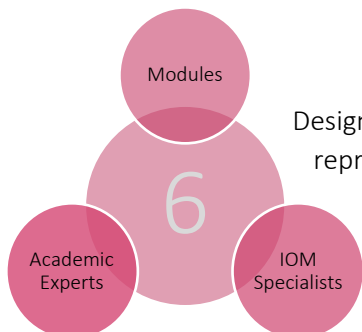

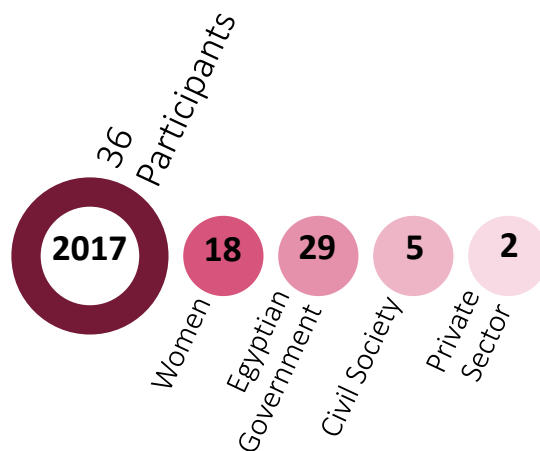
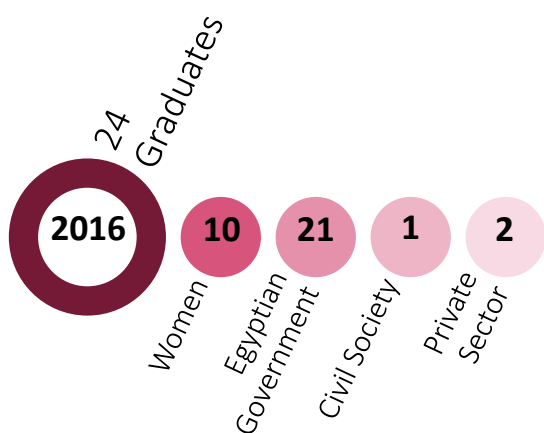
